	<p>We would really appreciate if each child could donate a box of TISSUES for their classroom. Also, it would be ideal if each child had their own personal pack of 'wet wipes' to use after fruit break.</p>
<p>Children need fresh water each day to stay hydrated and improve brain function. We are a SUNSMART school. Please ensure your child wears their HAT to school each day. We will remind them to wear their hat home each day. pb owl says "BE SAFE".</p> <p>Remember - "GOTCHA"</p>	
	<p>It is wonderful to see AND smell the variety of FRESH fruit the children are bringing to school for 'FRUIT BREAK'. Sometimes our classes smell like a giant fruit salad!!! YUM!</p>
<p>Painting is fun but can be messy. Please provide a PAINT SMOCK for your child to use during Art & Craft activities. A smock with elasticised neck and long sleeves is preferable. Oversized shirts with buttons can be a problem for small children to get on and off.</p>	
	<p>LIBRARY TIMES: 1 FIRE – Tuesday; 1 EARTH & 1 WATER – Friday. REMINd your child to bring their Library Bag to school on the appropriate day. ENCOURAGE your child to borrow from our well resourced library EACH week. SPORT DAYS: Monday and Thursday.</p>
	<p>COMMUNICATION is important and beneficial to your child. We encourage you to discuss with us any concerns you may have regarding your child's needs. Please note it is difficult to return phone calls during morning tea or lunch breaks as we are often on playground duty. However, we will return your call as soon as we possibly can. Or you can email us, but please also allow us time to reply.</p>
<p>TRANSPORT: Please ensure that your child knows how they are getting home and in which area they are to wait. If there is a change in their routine, or if you think they may not remember, please write a note and we will help them. Please complete the Home Time Arrangement form and send it in with your child if you have not done so already.</p>
